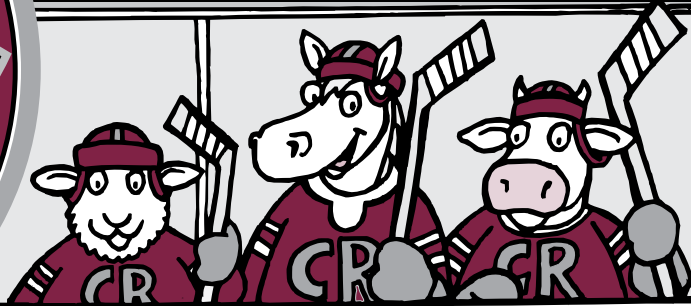

I encourage you to take full advantage of this fun filled weekend and explore the many different displays, activities, and of course the food!

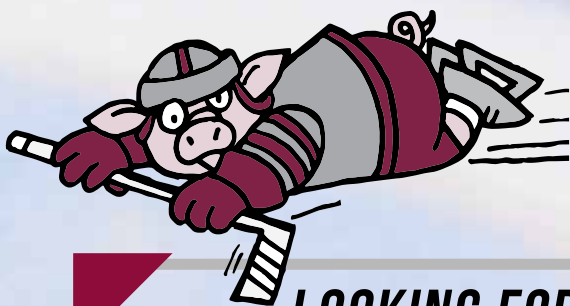

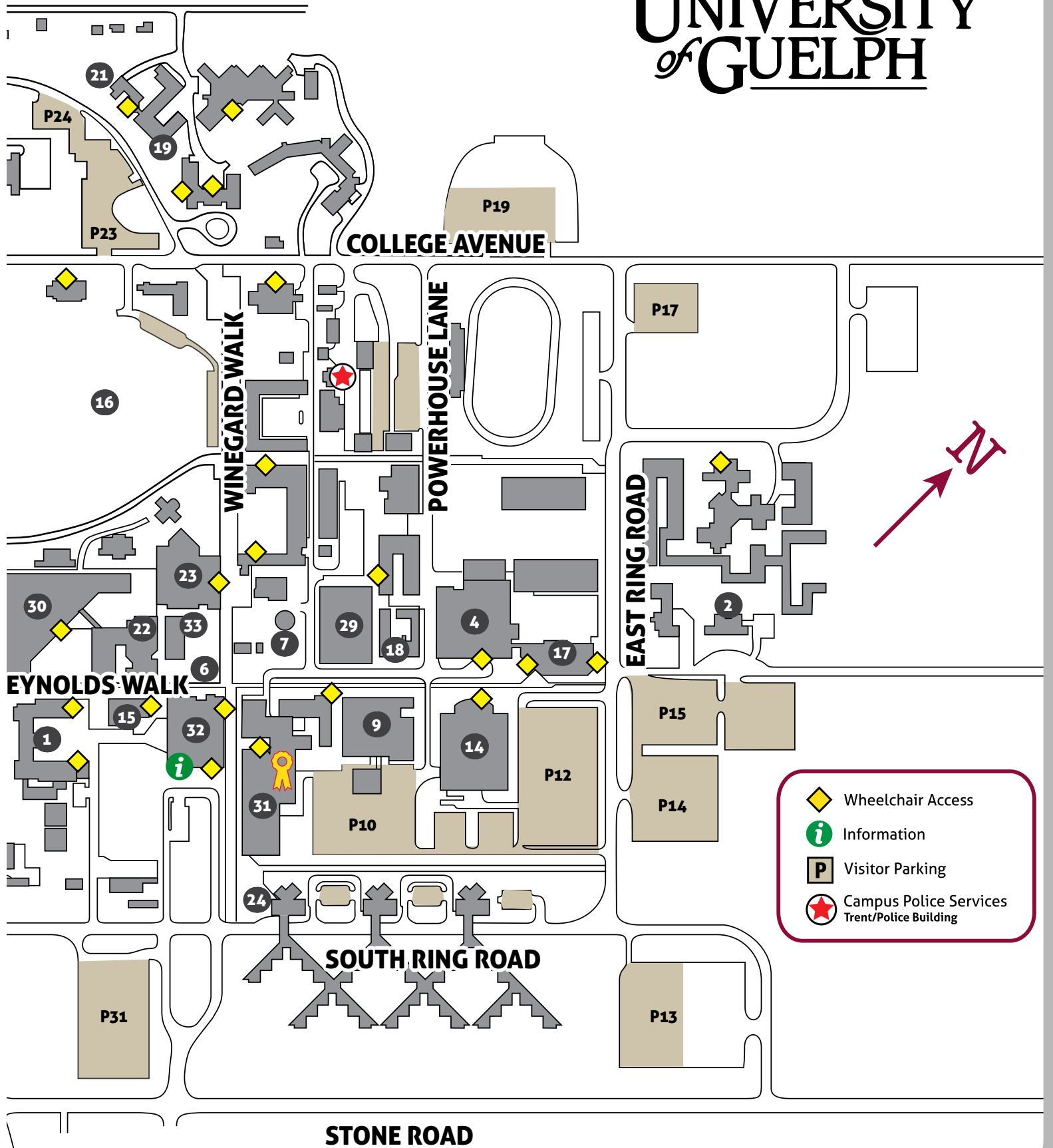
